ABA Strategies for Students with Traumatic Brain Injury

Behavioral/emotional difficulties following a TBI may be best addressed by combining interventions by healthcare professionals with strategies used by the person with TBI and those interacting with him/her. Physicians and Rehabilitation Psychologists/Neuropsychologists are two types of healthcare professional who can offer valuable interventions.

TBI Basics - Traumatic brain injury

Behavioral momentum is another strategy that has been used to increase positive behaviors and compliance in brain injury rehabilitation (Slifer et al., 1997). Behavior momentum involves making requests with which the students have a high probability of compliance before making a low-probability request—similar to the momentum of objects in motion.

Classroom Interventions for Students with Traumatic Brain ...

Treatment of children with TBI addresses abilities to function effectively in everyday real-life environments, including home, school, work, and community. Treatment can focus on developing and generalizing new skills, remediating lost functions, and/or addressing unwanted behaviors (Blosser & DePompei, 2003).
