Chopin's 24 Preludes, Op. 28, are a set of short pieces for the piano, one in each of the twenty-four keys, originally published in 1839. Chopin wrote them between 1835 and 1839, partly at Valldemossa , Mallorca , where he spent the winter of 1838–39 and where he had fled with George Sand and her children to escape the damp Paris weather. The prelude is noted for its repeating A ♭, which appears throughout the piece and sounds like raindrops to many listeners.

The Prelude, Op. 28, No. 1, played on the piano, is the first of Chopin's preludes. It was published in 1839 and dedicated to Camille Pleyel. Pianist Vladimir de Pachmann noted this prelude as "The first one is in a style that reminds one very forcibly of Schumann."
