The mastoid cavity is obliterated with bone pate´ and bone chips followed by replacement of the posterior canal wall segment. An anteriorly based musculoperiosteal Palva flap is used to cover the obliterated mastoid cavity.

The Forgotten Rambo Flap for Mastoid Cavity Obliteration

The oldest method with an open cavity in ears with mastoid extension of cholesteatoma if combined with partial obliteration is still suitable for less experienced surgeons. Transcanal atticotomy is suitable for limited epitympanic and tympanic cholesteatomas as long as it provides a direct view of the operative field.
