Pathology of cervix & uterus

Amputate cervix at lower uterine segment and ink the lower uterine segment end a different color (note, this is not a margin). Open cervix at 12:00, unless the carcinoma is clearly present at 12:00. Accurately measure lesion and note location.

FR 1 Invasive Cervical Carcinoma This is a specimen from a radical hysterectomy. You are looking at the cervix as you would see it on a speculum examination; note normal smooth squamous mucosa on the lower end, surrounding vaginal cuff removed with uterus and the ulcerated irregular area of the invasive carcinoma in the upper half of cervix.

Pathology The majority of cervical cancers are squamous-cell carcinomas. These lesions arise from the squamocolumnar junction and may be keratinizing or nonkeratinizing. Various methods of histologic grading have been used for cervical squamous-cell carcinoma, but these have no

significant impact on prognosis [5,6].

Carcinoma of the Uterine Cervix

A 73 year old woman presented with a right sided adnexal cystic mass. At laparotomy, this proved to be a benign serous ovarian cyst and an aggregation of thin walled subserosal and soft tissue cysts and spongy nodules up to 16 mm in diameter involving the side wall of the uterus and adjacent parametrium. These were removed by total abdominal hysterectomy and bilateral salpingo-oophorectomy.
