The next time one of the kids hears the word "trust" they'll think, "oh yeah, a Bible word!" And that's a shame. Trusting in God is so fundamentally important to the Christian walk , and yet in Sunday School we are happy just throwing around the term for half an hour, hoping that the kids will "catch on".

How to teach kids to trust God - Better Bible Teachers

Write in tiny letters, IN GOD WE TRUST, and cover with a little piece of saran wrap or laminating material. Tell children to keep their TRUST COIN in their wallets or in their Bibles to remember WHO to Trust all the time! SING A SONG: Trust and Obey, or Trust in the Lord with all your Heart. TRUST SNACK TIME: Divide children into groups of two. Let children feed each other while blindfolded with a cupcake or a cookie, etc, for their snack, if time allows!

Reassure them that them that God is bigger than that compartmentalization.
