Mammary gland sarcomas (fibrosarcoma or osteosarcoma) are uncommon but have been reported. The average survival time  $\frac{Page}{7/11}$ 

for mammary gland sarcomas of any kind is short, usually between 9 and 12 months. Inflammatory mammary gland tumors are highly aggressive and typically present as a rapidly growing tumor with ulceration, edema and erythema.

### Current recommendations for mammary gland tumors in dogs

Mammary (or breast) tumors are common in female dogs, but rare in male dogs and cats. Surgical removal is recommended for most mammary tumors. Chemotherapy may be required following surgery in some cases.

Mammary Gland Tumors in Dogs This type of cancer occurs primarily in female dogs that aren't spayed as well as those spayed after 2 years of age, although male and female dogs of

any age and breed may develop mammary tumors. Certain breeds, including Poodles and various spaniel dog breeds, have an increased risk.

These two forms of the disease have different diagnostics, treatments, management, and prognosis (see handout "Benign Mammary Tumors in Dogs" for information on the non-cancerous form of the disease). There are several different types of malignant mammary tumors, with carcinomas being the most common. Carcinomas arise from epithelial (skin) cells, tubules of the mammary glands, or other cells found in the mammary chain.
